GENERAL INFORMATION

Redemption is for those who are tired of living under the weight of sin and fed up with nominal Christianity. Whether you're trapped in some secret sin, struggling with a recent tragedy, haunted by past abuse, fighting an addiction, depression, or one of the hosts of other life crippling issues Jesus Christ has the power to liberate you. ## PURPOSE

The purpose of Redemption is to declare, explore and experience the freedom that God purchased for the world at the expense of His son's life.

Through His death on the cross Jesus accomplished the task of redeeming all believers from the curse of sin. That redemptive act, like a diamond, reflects its light in many different angles. In view of this, the concept of redemption can minister to each of our hearts no matter where we're at in life and regardless of the problems we're facing.

## REVOLVING DOOR MINISTRY

Redemption exists to proclaim the need for people to receive the new life God offers and to help them as they learn to live it out. The ministry is intent upon giving special care to those who are in the midst of a struggle with the crippling issues of life. (Lk.13:6-9).

*3 He also spoke this parable: "A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. 7 Then he said to the keeper of his vineyard, 'Look, for three years I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree and find none. Cut it down; why does it use up the ground?' 8 But he answered and said to him, 'Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and fertilize it. 9 And if it bears fruit, well".... (Luke 13:6-9)*

After this time of special care a true believer can respond to the redeeming power of God's word and begin to move forward in their relationship with Jesus Christ.

## FORMAT

Redemption group takes place on Friday and Sunday nights from 7p.m. to 9:30p.m.

The evening includes two sessions:

A main session where each week Christ is worshipped and a unique aspect of our redemption is taught. And a breakout session where a small group undertakes the challenge of applying what was taught to their own life circumstance.

## ENTRY

Redemption cycles through a 10 week course. Anyone desiring to attend the main session is welcomed, but those planning on being a part of the breakout sessions should fill out a registration form or if necessary call 471-1450
